Zondervan Guide to Cults and Religious Movements (15 volumes). I am the designer and editor of a 15-volume series on the cults, published by Zondervan Publishers. The first eight volumes were released in April of 1995 with the second set of seven released in February of 1998. The series includes contributions from over a dozen of the top cult apologists in the United States. In addition to editing the series, I am author of three volumes: *Unmasking the Cults* (a general introduction to the cults), *Unitarian Universalism*, and *Truth and Error*.
